Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, April 17 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of obedience/rally classes.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. The whole entry form page must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers: Dogs can be moved to a higher level of competition in any event if a title has been attained. Transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the event in question.

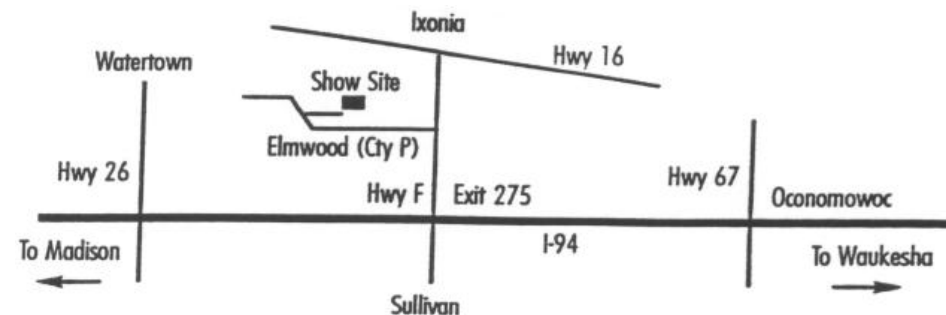

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

or run in any amateur or Open field trial all age stake.

Non-Regular Classes (multiple dog entries)

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Stud Dogs

Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excusal.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class

For two dogs similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by one or two handlers.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class.

Generations Class

Open to groups of 3 dogs representing 3 direct/consecutive generations which will be judged as a group: 1) Grandsire or granddam, 2) son or daughter, 3) grandson or granddaughter.

The individual dogs need not be of the same sex, nor have the same owner.

Each individual dog must also be entered in some other regular or non-regular class at the show (conformation, sweepstakes, obedience, or rally). Enter "Generations" in the Additional entry box on the entry form. Please include the names of the other dogs in the entry.

First place each class 30% of entry fees for the class

Second place each class 20% of entry fees for the class

Other Conformation Awards

Award of Merit: At the judge's discretion, up to 2 dogs/bitches who have competed in the Best of Breed judging may be selected to receive an Award of Merit after BOB, BOS, BOW and Selects are awarded.

Best Puppy, Best Bred By Exhibitor, Best Veteran: 6-9 & 9-12 class winners will compete for Best Puppy. BBE class winners will compete for Best BBE. Veteran class winners will compete for Best Veteran.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

Please enter your dog's jump height on the entry form for all classes with jumps.

Transfers to the next higher level in both obedience and rally are allowed per AKC rules and regulations. Bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after closing will receive a refund of entry fees, less \$5/entry, if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for English Springer Spaniels that are 4 months of age but under 6 months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entries will be taken at ringside.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. The Best of Breed winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the total number of dogs competing. The Best of Opposite Sex winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.
Dogs Competing – Points: 2 dogs: 1 pt • 4 dogs: 2 pts • 8 dogs: 3 pts • 12 dogs: 4 pts • 16 dogs: 5 pts

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered English Springer Spaniels who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants must be entered in a regular class. Classes are divided by sex.

6 mos & under 9 mos • 9 mos & under 12 mos
12 mos & under 15 mos • 15 mos & under 18 mos

The club will retain 10% of the total fees. The remainder will be divided as follows:

Best in Puppy Sweepstakes: 18% • Best of Opposite Sex in Puppy Sweepstakes: 8%
First Place in each class: 8%

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered English Springer Spaniels who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants do not need to be entered in a regular class, and may be altered. Classes are divided by sex.

7 yrs & under 9 yrs • 9 yrs & under 11 yrs • 11 years & over

The club will retain 10% of the total fees. The remainder will be divided as follows:

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes: 20% • Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes: 10%
First Place in each class: 10%

ALTERED SWEEPSTAKES

Altered Sweepstakes is open to all altered AKC registered English Springer Spaniels. Entrants do not need to be entered in any other class. Classes are divided by sex.

Altered Performance: for dogs who have earned an AKC performance title AND are not champions of record

Altered Open: for any altered dog/bitch

The club will retain 10% of the total fees. The remainder will be divided as follows:

Best in Altered Sweepstakes: 20% • Best of Opposite Sex in Altered Sweepstakes: 10%
First Place in each class: 15%

ALL Sweepstakes: List the entered Sweepstakes class in the Additional Entry box on the entry form.

PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a Pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children at least 5 years of age and under 9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog.

Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

▶ A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.

▶ Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.

▶ All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.

▶ A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

The class will be held at lunchtime when the ring becomes available. **Registration is required and will be 9-11am at the show site.** Cost is \$5 per entry. Each entry's adult member will sign a liability release as part of the entry process. All participants will receive a rainbow ribbon.
