Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CDT Wednesday September 1, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will not be accepted if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms with fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than September 1, and received no later than September 4, or the entry will not be accepted. Entry fees must include a \$2.00 charge per entry form submitted. **Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

Entry Acknowledgements: To ensure the receipt of your entries, it is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. If you do not have email, send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope with your entry, which the Secretary will return upon entry receipt. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded.

Moveups to Best of Breed or Open Jr Show classes: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open if the junior has earned a third 1st place after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

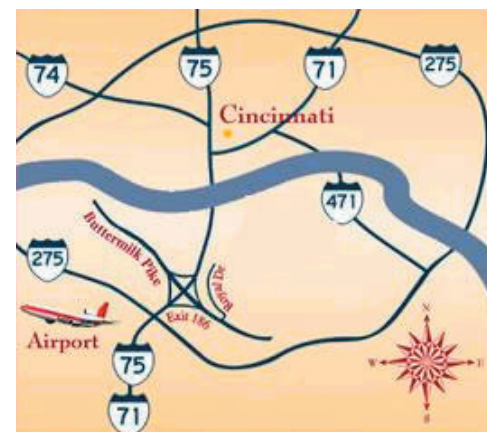

Exhibitors cannot be or have been a professional handler, an AKC conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to, or be an immediate family member of, a professional handler.

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches shown with two of their offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring.
Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Award of Merit : At the judge's discretion, the judge may select or recall into the ring up to 5 dogs/bitches to receive an Award of Merit after BOB, BOS & BOW are awarded. These Awards are for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered Beaucerons who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants must also be entered in a regular class. Indicate the sweepstakes class in the Additional Entry box on the entry form. Champions of Record may compete.

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show.

The Novice class is divided:

Novice Junior - 9 years and under 11 years on the day of the show;
Novice Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
Novice Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show.

The Open class is divided:

Open Junior - 9 years and under 11 years on the day of the show;
Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
