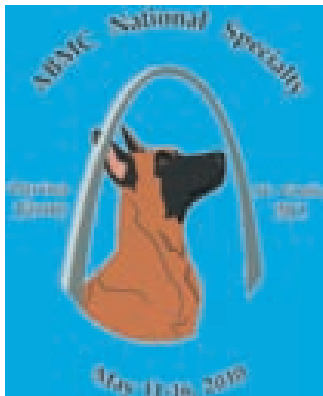

Entries must be received by 6 pm CDT Wednesday April 14th, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is preferred) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by AKC. Envelopes containing more than 10 dogs' entries will be refused.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient funds will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Partial refunds will be made for bitches who come into season after the closing date, if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the secretary prior to the start of judging.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or scanned & emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms with fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than April 14, and received no later than April 17, or the entry will not be accepted. Entry fees must include a \$2.00 charge per entry form submitted. **Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

Entry Acknowledgements: Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts, as well as final confirmations, via email. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If receipt of entry notification is desired, a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope must be included with the entry forms.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded.

MEASURING: All dogs participating in this trial must have an AKC height card or they will need to be measured prior to running in the trial. A VMO will be in attendance to measure for official height cards.

Copies of height cards DO NOT need to be sent with entries or shown at the trial!

It is the owner's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running. Awards may be cancelled if the dog is not measured before running.

See the entry form for the appropriate box to check regarding height cards. A "temporary form" is the yellow form given when a rep or VMO measures a dog. A "permanent card" is the wallet-sized white card sent by AKC.

CLASS ORDER (each day): FAST - Standard - JWW; Excellent - Open - Novice for all classes. Heights 4" to 26" Thursday, 26" to 4" Friday. Judging will begin at 8am each day.

SITE INFORMATION: One ring (100' x 100' on grass) will be used. There will be a 40'x80' tent with a concrete floor adjacent to the ring for crating. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs and yourselves. **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the trial with no monies refunded.**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Weave poles will be 24" on center.

FOOD: There will be food for sale on site through Purina Farms. Workers will receive lunch vouchers.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breeds are not able to enter these trials.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: If a dog earns an agility title before this event it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice must be sent to the trial secretary **no later than 6pm on Monday, May 10.** Email moveups are encouraged. Moveups for Friday's trial must be submitted in writing by the awarding of ribbons for the last class on Thursday. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. **No verbal changes will be accepted.**

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ABMC and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place teams in each class and height division. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to those teams receiving qualifying scores. Malinois special awards: The high-scoring Malinois in each Std, JWW & FAST class (Regular 20"/24", Preferred 16"/20") will receive a toy on Thursday and a slip lead on Friday. Each day's High in Trial Standard Malinois and High in Trial JWW Malinois will receive a training bag. Each day's overall High in Trial Malinois will receive a Purina Pro Plan fleece blanket, sponsored by Purina. All High in Trial winners will be calculated first by highest score, then fastest yards per second. Qualifying scores are required for all prizes.

VERSATILITY AWARD: The 2010 ABMC National Specialty Most Versatile Malinois Award includes agility. Malinois must participate and earn points (i.e. qualify) in at least four (4) of the following six (6) venues: agility, conformation, herding, obedience, rally, and/or tracking. Dogs must be signed up to compete for the Versatility Award. Check the box on any entry form to sign up. 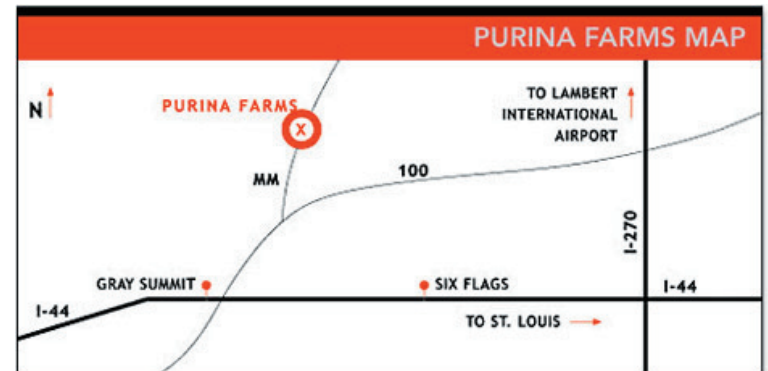

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete: however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partner's program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
