ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry fees: (including AKC recording/event service fees for regular class entries)

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **CRSC/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by **6 pm MDT Wednesday August 25**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms with fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than August 25, and received no later than August 30, or the entry will not be accepted. **Entry fees must include a \$2.00 charge per entry form submitted. Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

Entry Acknowledgements: It is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.

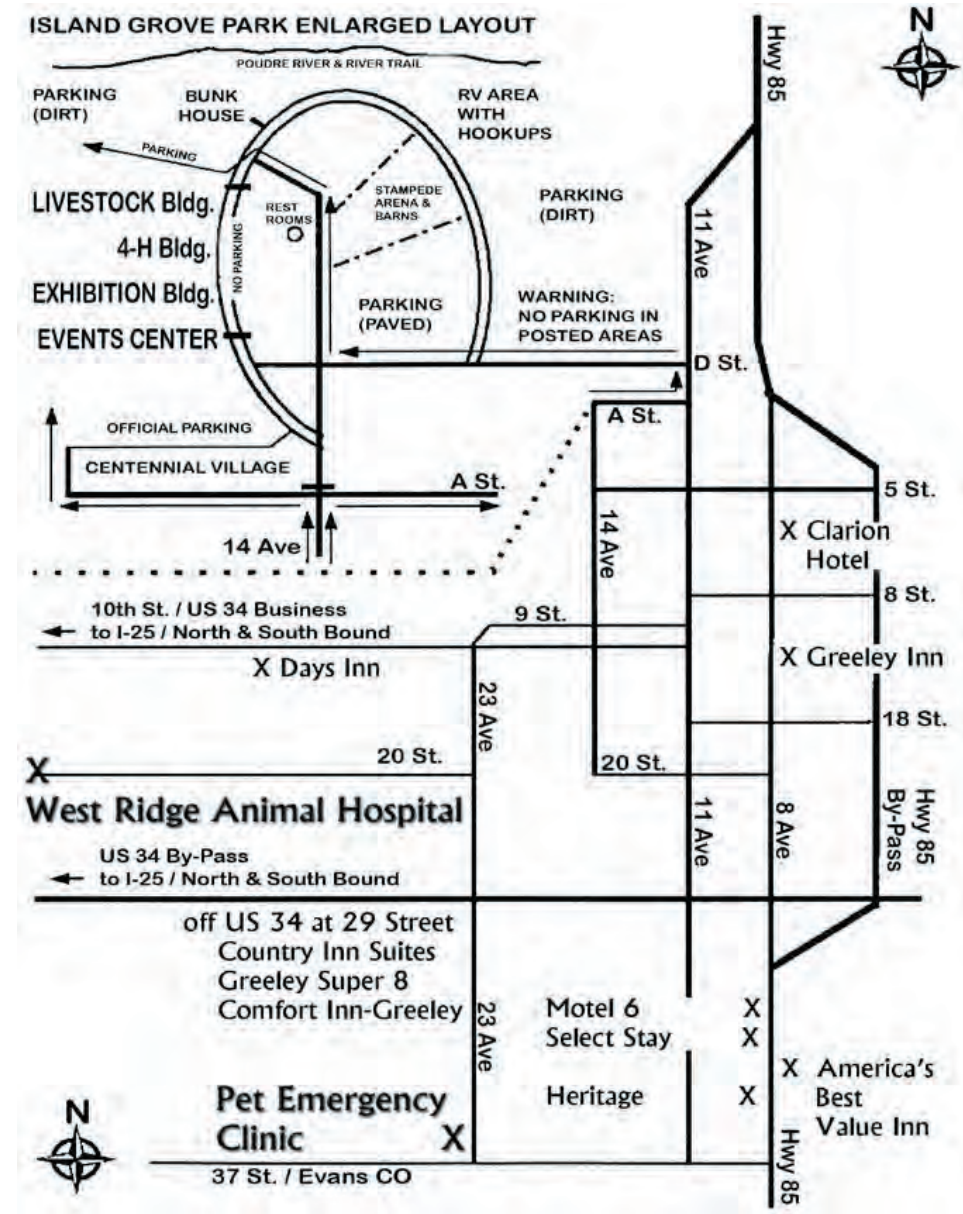

SHOW SITE INFORMATION

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors 1 pm to 10 pm, Thursday, 9/9; 7 am to 10 pm, Friday, 9/10; 6 am to 10 pm, Saturday, 9/11; and at 6 am, Sunday, 9/12. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, 9/12.

- ◆ Dogs will be allowed overnight in buildings provided that owner information is left on crates.
- ◆ NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN SOFT SIDED CRATES.
- ◆ All buildings will be locked by 10 pm nightly and reopen at 6 am. Security Guard will be on duty from 10 pm to 6 am.
- ◆ NO GENERATORS to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.
- ◆ PLEASE, NO BABY STROLLERS in the show buildings.

GROOMING & CRATING

Exercise Pens will be allowed in the Livestock Barn ONLY.

Crates must be stacked whenever possible.

Grooming will be allowed OUTDOORS & IN THE FOLLOWING BUILDINGS: Events Center, Exhibition Building & Livestock Barn.

There is ample grooming space – Roping off an area or saving spaces will not be allowed, unless authorized by the ECKC Show Committee. This will be strictly enforced.

A crate holding area will be available and marked in the Events Center. Exhibitors may use this area a few minutes before to immediately after their breed is judged. Grooming, scissoring, etc. WILL NOT BE PERMITTED in this area.

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs they are exhibiting or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site.

Providing clean up tools & supplies will be the responsibility of each Specialty Club.

NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN SOFT SIDED CRATES AT ANY TIME.

Dogs must be under control at all times, including while being walked or exercised on Flexi-Leashes.

PARKING

10 MINUTE TIME LIMIT FOR LOADING & UNLOADING AREAS AT EXHIBITION BUILDING & LIVESTOCK BARN. This will be enforced. Please do not leave vehicles unattended.

Vehicles in NO PARKING, FIRE LANES, OR WITHIN 20' OF A FIRE HYDRANT will be ticketed and towed at the owners expense.

Day Parking

The paved lot south of the stadium (approx. one block from the Exhibition Building) is available for day parking. There are no hookups in this lot. Additional day parking is available FREE OF CHARGE on the east side of the park and west of the show buildings. These are gravel lots.

Reserved Day Parking

A Reserved Day Parking Area will be provided in the lot behind the show buildings. Each vehicle must have a permit for the show weekend. Reserved Day Parking people will have "In & Out" privileges.

No grooming or exercise pens will be permitted unless an additional space is purchased.

COST is \$25.00 per space from 1:00 pm Thursday, 9/9 thru Sunday, 9/12.

Please use the Overnight Parking Reservation Form on the next page – there is a space at the bottom of the form to check off for Reserved Day Parking.

Reserved Day Parking deadline: Wednesday, August 25. No checks will be accepted after this date. After this date, parking must be paid in cash, at the gate.

Exhibitors will NOT be allowed to park next to the motor homes of friends or agents. They must have a permit for the lot and park within the lined spaces. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed at the owner's expense.

NOTE: The club(s) assume no responsibility for personal injury or death of any person; theft, injury or death of any animal; or damage of any property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show.

Overnight Parking

Overnight parking will be available on the show grounds. You will park at the direction of the ECKC Parking Staff and Committee. This parking is a privilege extended by the ECKC and this privilege can and will be withdrawn from those who do not follow these rules, regulations and instructions of the club members, officers and guards on duty. Any breach of these terms will be reported to the Show Committee. The fees are charged to help defray the costs of the security guards.

Reserved overnight parking will be available beginning at 1:00 pm Thursday, September 9. All RVs must be in their sites by 8:00 pm Friday, September 10.

Anyone parking prior to this time will need to pay an additional fee to the City of Greeley per day. Check-in at Island Grove Regional Park Office, 501 N. 14th Ave, 7am to 3:30 pm Monday–Wednesday. Vehicles in the park before Thursday, September 9, and not in their assigned parking spaces, WILL BE MOVED on Friday, September 10.

- No overnight parking in Island Grove Park without a paid fee.
- All overnight parking with electric and specific location is based on breed(s) shown and time and date of receipt of reservation request – by mail or on site.
- No vehicles longer than 50 feet will be parked on the oval.
- All units must be self-contained. Exhibitors will be responsible for clean-up of their areas. Trash dumpsters will be provided. No discharge of greywater or sanitary tanks is permitted. RV dump site is available near the show grounds north of the Stampede Arena, Thursday thru Sunday, 10 am to 6 pm.
- All set-ups must be made within your assigned space. Any vehicle with a pop-out or slideout extension must have cones (provided by the vehicle owner) placed beneath the extension portion of the rig.
- If you want to park next to a friend, mail your reservation and fees in the same envelope. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Request for refunds must be made by entry closing date, after which refunds will not be made. YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE CONFIRMATION OF YOUR RESERVATION IN THE MAIL !

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collie (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
