All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **KFCS/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, September 20 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$20 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. No refunds to be made for bitches entered in obedience who come into season after the closing date.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/ContactCAPER.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to Best of Breed, Open/Master Jr Show classes, or a higher obedience level: If, after the close of entries for this event, a dog has completed the requirements for a championship or an obedience title, the dog may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class or to a higher level obedience class. Juniors can be transferred to Open or Master if the junior has fulfilled the requirements of the class after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made in writing to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging for the show.

HOTEL INFORMATION: Exhibitors must contact motels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. Some require pet fees and/or have limits on the number of dogs. Please use extreme caution in the treatment of motel space. PLEASE be a responsible motel guest.

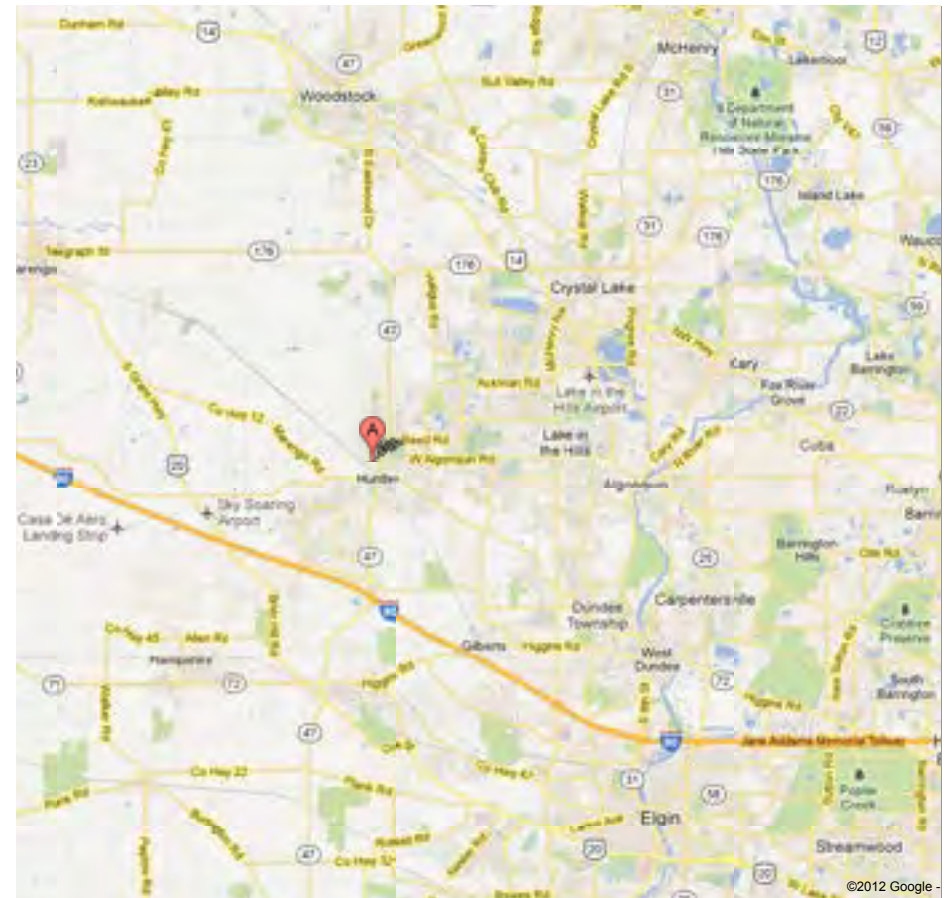

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered Keeshonden who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" the entry in Sweepstakes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

Site Information

IMPORTANT: TO ALL EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

In order for us to be able to keep renting this facility please adhere to these rules.

The building will NOT OPEN UNTIL 6:30 AM, DO NOT COME ANY EARLIER THAN 6:30 AM.

We know that some of your dogs are very exuberant and can't help but bark. For those that are not able to prevent your dogs from barking, please park in between the buildings so our neighbors in homes to the west are not disturbed.

Do not walk your dogs along the fence on the west side of the drainage area. Walk dogs on the east side of the drainage area and along the south side of the buildings.

Please do not park in the parking spots directly in front of the gymnastics club next to us.

If anyone is found breaking these rules they will be asked to leave without any refund.
