All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **LSSC/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by **6 pm MDT Wednesday September 13**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted.

All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the AKC.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both sides of the entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to [www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm](http://www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm) and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

**Entry Acknowledgements:** It is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

**Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries.** Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of \$5 or less will not be refunded.

**Moveups to Best of Breed or Open/Master Jr Show classes:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open if the junior has earned a third Novice 1st place, or Master if the junior has earned a 10th Open 1st place, after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary designate at least 30 minutes prior to the start of regular conformation judging at each show.

Award of Merit : At the judge's discretion, the judge may award up to 1 Award of Merit for every 5 dogs entered in Best of Breed competition, after BOB, BOS & BOW & the Selects are awarded. All competitors in the ring for Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award if the judge desires to award it.

### Non-Regular Classes

Veteran Dogs, 8 yrs & over	Veteran Bitches, 8 yrs & over
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Entrants may be altered. Winners eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

### Best Puppy, Best Bred By Exhibitor, Best Veteran

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy.

First place in each BBE class will compete for Best BBE. If a BBE class winner is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that BBE dog/bitch will automatically win Best BBE.

First place in each Veteran class will compete for Best Veteran. If a Veteran wins Best of Breed, it will automatically win Best Veteran.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

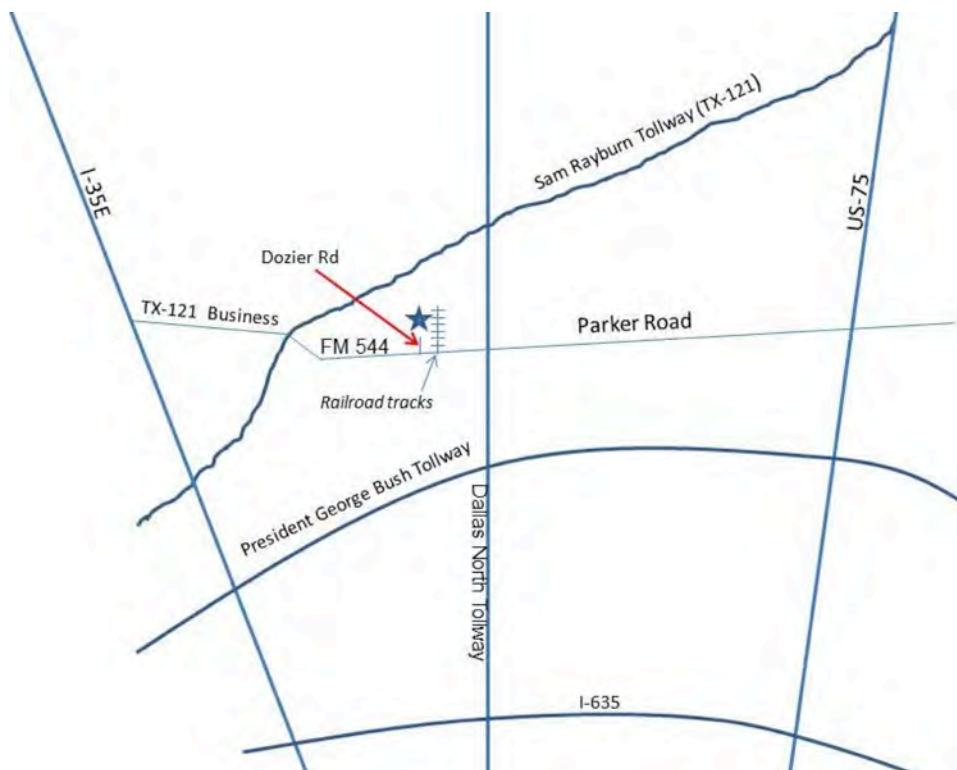
### FROM US 75 or Dallas North Tollway

### FROM I-35E

You can take either Business 121 or TX 121 (Sam Rayburn Tollway) to 544, go east (will be a right turn) on 544. The name will change to Parker Road. Stay on Parker. After you pass Plano Parkway look for Sage Hill Drive on your left, Dozier Road will be the next left (between SPEC's and Select Specialty Hospital).

## SHOW SITE INFORMATION

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am Saturday, September 30. All dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following judging.

No smoking is allowed in the building. If you smoke outside, do not leave your butts on the ground.

**BATHROOM USE:** Because the property is still on a septic system, you may not flush toilet paper or feminine products. Place used paper and those products in the container provided. Please make sure your children understand this or accompany them to the bathroom.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in ring during judging only. Dogs and crates may be brought ringside.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Lone Star Schipperke Club and its agents will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

## GROOMING & CRATING

Absolutely no exercise pens will be allowed in the building at any time. Public exercise pens will be provided and must be attended by owner or handler while in use. In lieu of ex-pens, you may use the area at the back of the building to exercise your dogs but you **MUST** clean up after your dog. There is a garbage can and scoops for your use.

There will be no space provided for unentered dogs at this show.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in & around their crates and are expected to comply with all Club rules as laid out and enforced by the Lone Star Schipperke Club. Damage to hotel, motel, RV park, or show grounds property will be subject to Show Committee Hearing & action.

## PARKING

Do not park in front of the entrance to the building, this area is reserved for judges; use the parking lot to the left of the building.

No overnight parking is allowed.

No sawdust is allowed to be used on the grounds – inside or outside.

Positively no dumping of holding tanks allowed. No filling of water tanks from any water source on the grounds will be permitted. Violators of these parking regulations will be prosecuted and vehicles towed away, at owner's expense, without notice.
