All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **MSSC/CAPER, 4044 S. 92nd St, Greenfield WI 53228.**

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wed. September 20th**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds for bitches in season in obedience, and rally will be given (less \$10/entry), if notification (including veterinary certification) is made to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging for the day.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to barb@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/ContactCAPER.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2.00 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Entry Acknowledgements: To ensure the receipt of your entries, it is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. If you do not have email, send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope with your entry, which the Secretary will return upon entry receipt. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be emailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.

Move Ups to Best of Breed: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

The show giving club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees etc assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Owners or Agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Dogs allowed in rings only during judging.
2. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal or external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors/handlers should have proof of rabies vaccinations with them for entered dogs.
3. The Show Committee has the right to limit grooming equipment & stack crates if it is necessary. There is no roping off of areas, ropes will be removed. **NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.** Owners/Handlers are responsible for clean conditions in the crating area. It is recommended that dogs in crates not be left alone. Crating & Grooming are to be done in designated areas only. Limited electrical access in free grooming area.
4. Exercise dogs in designated areas only. Clean up after your dogs. If your dog eliminates in the ring, you will be provided with necessities to clean it up. Public exercise pens will be available.
5. **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RESTROOMS. NO WASHING OF DOGS OR DOG BOWLS IN THE REST ROOMS.**
6. **NO EXERCISE PENS OR COCKER PENS ALLOWED IN PAVILLION 1.**
7. The public address system will be used at the discretion of the show giving clubs.
8. Exhibitors should be aware of recently reported attempts by animal rights groups to open crates and release dogs at dog shows. Dogs should not be left unattended at any time.
9. Loading and unloading will be restricted.
10. Ringside crating may be setup in Exhibitor aisle as space allows, 15 minutes prior to ring time and must be removed immediately upon completion of judging.
11. Every attempt will be made to keep the show site and all exhibitor's possessions secure; however, the show giving club, their officials, members and agents are not responsible for any loss or damage to equipment or animals left in the pavillion at any time.
12. This is a **NON-SMOKING FACILITY** according to Federal and State regulations. A FINE can be imposed if in violation. **THIS WILL BE MONITORED.**

SHOW SITE AVAILABILITY

The Show site will be available to exhibitors at 8:00 am on Friday, October 6, 2017 (**NO EXCEPTIONS**) and 6:00 am on Saturday & Sunday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday, October 8, 2017. The building will be locked at 11:00 pm on Friday & Saturday nights.

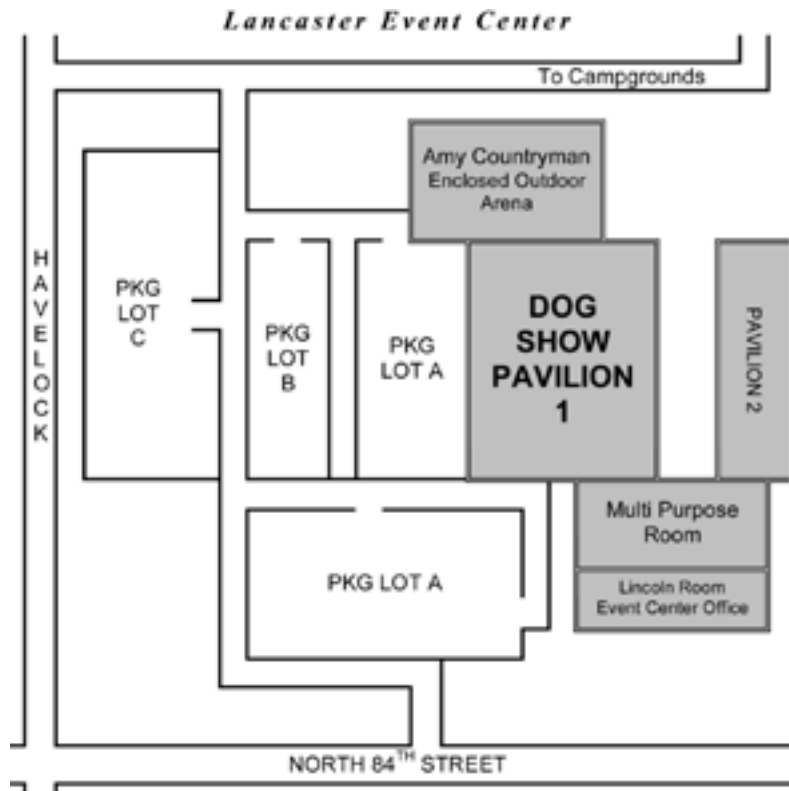
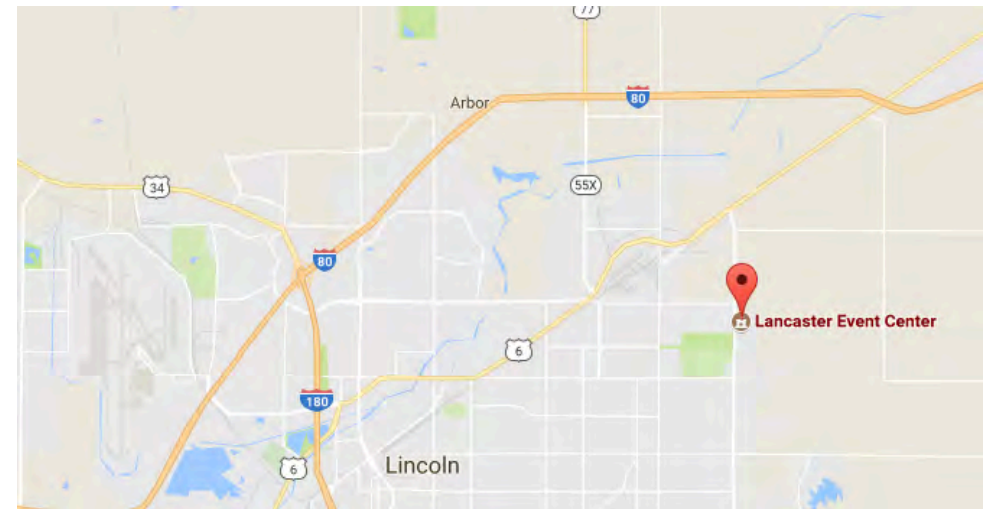

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/ Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
