All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **RMMF/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday October 11**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com & clicking on the PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

**Entry Acknowledgements:** It is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

**Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of \$5 or less will not be refunded.**

**Moveups to Best of Breed:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the onsite Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Clean-Up Is Your Responsibility

If your dog soils the parking lot or show grounds, it is your responsibility to clean up after it. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that all clean-up is your responsibility. Award of Merit: At the judge's discretion, an Award of Merit may be given to those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. Award of Merit winners will be selected after BOB, BOS & Selects are awarded. The number of awards is determined by the number of dogs entered in the Best of Breed class: 1-5 = 1; 6-10 = 2; 11-15 = 3; 16-20 = 4; 21 or more = 5.

### Non-Regular Classes (single dog entries)

Veteran Dogs, 6 yrs & under 8 yrs	Veteran Bitches, 6 yrs & under 8 yrs
Veteran Dogs, 8 yrs & under 10 yrs	Veteran Bitches, 8 yrs & under 10 yrs

Entrants may be altered. Winners eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

### Non-Regular Classes (multiple dog entries)

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

#### Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excuses.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

#### Brace Class

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form.

Champions of record and altered dogs may be entered.

#### Team Class

For four dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by up to four handlers. All dogs in each Team must have at least one common owner. Champions of record and altered dogs may be entered. Entrants must be entered in some other class, and each must be on a separate entry form. Please submit Team entries together and/or use a Team Name on the entry form to designate which dogs are together on a Team.

### Best Puppy, Best Veteran, Best Bred By Exhibitor

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy.

First place in each Veteran class will compete for Best Veteran. If a Veteran wins Best of Breed, it will automatically win Best Veteran.

First place in each BBE class will compete for Best BBE. If the BBE class winner is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that BBE dog/bitch will automatically win Best BBE.

### Three reasons to get your entries in early!

- 1) Entry fee checks are not cashed until closing
- 2) There is NO CHARGE to change or cancel entries before closing
- 3) Armband numbers are assigned randomly, not by order of entry receipt

## SWEEPSTAKES

### Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Mastiffs who are 6 months but less than 18 months old on the day of the sweepstakes. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Champions of record may NOT be entered in Puppy Sweepstakes. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class, with age division, in the space provided for Additional Classes on the entry form.

Champions of record are eligible to compete. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class, with age division, in the space provided for Additional Classes on the entry form.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. **Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.** Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

\* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.
