Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday**, **April 10** after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of that event's classes.

Fax/email/online entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 262-500-5080, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both sides (the entire page) of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted.

Online entries are via the Online Entry link at www.caper-dogs.com.

Payment is made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. Payment <u>must</u> include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

<u>Transfers to higher levels:</u> Transfers are available to dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements to advance to a higher level after the closing date, in any offered sport. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for which the transfer is requested.

Working Sweepstakes

Dogs entered in Working Sweepstakes must have earned a Working Dog Certificate from BSCA. You must have received a Merit Award in 2023 or before, with it processed and approved by the Merit Committee. Entrants need not be entered in one of the regular classes, and may be altered.

Best Bred By Exhibitor: For winners of Bred By Exhibitor Puppy and Bred By Exchibitor Adult classes and shown by a breeder/owner (professional handlers must be a breeder/owner of record).

Best Puppy: For winners of Puppy 6-9 & 9-12 and Bred By Exhibitor Puppy classes.

Non-Regular Classes (multiple dog entries)

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excusals.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form.

Team Class

For four dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

All dogs in each Team must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES (National only)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. or received payment for handling a dog.

SATURDAY, MAY 11

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Belgian Sheepdogs who are four months of age but

under six months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers who are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in this class.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entres will be taken at ringside.
- Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppies for the judge.
- Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of considerationin the judging process for this competition.

- Dogs must qualify (per the AKC definition of the event) in two of the six AKC performance events Regular Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Herding, Agility, Scentwork.
- 2. Dogs must qualify for, and participate in, a regular, non regular or sweepstakes conformation class.
- 3. Dogs that are excused or disqualified from participation in any event, not including normal non-qualifying scores in performance events, will be disallowed from further Versatility competition for 2024.
- 4. Performance event points: Dogs that qualify in more than one class in the same category of the six AKC performance events may count only the higher class or score.
- 5. Ties will be broken by awarded/adding in, tie-breaking points see the chart for point schedule, with the exception of – any dog that qualifies in all SIX venues, regardless of level or point value will be awarded the trophy, In case of a tie, the dog who qualifies in all SIX venues, in the higher class will be awarded the trophy. 
