Trial hours 7am-5pm each day - Trial site is in the CENTRAL time zone

Entries Open on September 10 at 8 am CDT at the Trial Secretary's address – Any entries received before this date/time will be returned.

Final Closing date October 15 at 6 pm CDT

after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Ch 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules

Entry Limits: 30 sheep runs & 20 duck runs per day

(Max 50 run limit for all trial entries combined, per day)

Sheep: A Course Started, Intermediate, Advanced
Pre-trial Test, Herding Test

Ducks: A & B Course, each with Started, Intermediate, Advanced

Entry fees: \$50 per test or trial entry
include AKC recording fees
\$25 per FEO entry

There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks.

Entry Payment:

By **check or money order** (made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs.com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal or credit card** at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.**

All mail must be left with no acceptance signature required. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received **by email** (preferred) or **in legible writing** prior to the October 15 closing date, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. No refunds for entry form errors made by the entrant. All entries will be acknowledged via email.

Entries not on official herding entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms, without the Release Form along with the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. An alternate list will be kept for all entries over the entry limits. FEO entries, at \$25/run, will be accepted if entry limits are not reached.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from the competition by actions of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire or Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate runs; if no alternate runs, no refund will be given.

SITE INFORMATION:

This event is being held at a working farm. Please close all latches and gates. **Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs and themselves!** Morning coffee/snacks will be available. Lunch will be wrapped sandwiches & bags of chips. If the weather is cold, a hot item will be available. Bottled water will be available all weekend. Cost for lunch is \$5 per person.

Dogs MUST be confined in vehicles or crated. Crates/ex-pens need to be placed only in the areas designated by the Trial Committee. Dogs should be leashed when not in the arena. Bring your shade tents, chairs, water and rain gear.

All sheep trial classes will be in a 135'x235' arena. A course duck classes will be in a 50'x100' arena. B course outruns will be 60 feet for Started, 75 feet for Intermediate and 100 feet for Advanced. HT will be in a 100'x100' arena, PT in a 100'x200' arena.

Moveup requests need to be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the day's test/trial. If there are Alternate entries, all alternates must report to the Trial Secretary before the start of the day's classes. If you do not, your spot may be given to an alternate in an earlier class.

Bitches in season will run last in the Test classes and in catalog order in the Trial classes.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

From the north on I-65: Take Exit 20B toward Owensboro/Bowling Green and merge onto I-165 North

4.8 miles, take Exit 5 (US-68) toward Russellville/Bowling Green, turn left onto US-68

3.3 miles, turn Right onto KY-1083/Browning Rd

1.1 miles, turn Right onto Fuqua Rd, follow gravel drive to High Reaches Farm on Right

From the south on I-65: Take Exit 20A-B toward Owensboro/Scottsville

Take Exit 20B toward Owensboro/Bowling Green, then follow From the North directions above

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collie (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles).

2. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
