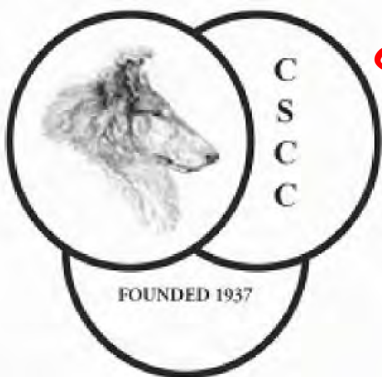

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **CSCC/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CST Wednesday, Wednesday January 31 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of obedience/rally classes.

**Fax/email/online entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 262-500-5080, or emailed to [secretary@caper-dogs.com](mailto:secretary@caper-dogs.com). Both sides (the entire page) of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted.

Payment is made via PayPal or credit card by going to [www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm](http://www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm) and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

**Transfers to higher levels:** Transfers are available to dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements to advance to a higher level after the closing date, in any offered sport. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for which the transfer is requested.

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Variety or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy.  
First place in each BBE class will compete for Best BBE. If a BBE class winner is Best of Variety or Best of Winners, that BBE dog/bitch will automatically win Best BBE.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**Novice class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Open class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. The Open class is divided (ages as of the day of the show):

**Master class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

## PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES (Saturday am only)

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Collies who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All Sweepstakes entrants **MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class** at either Saturday specialty show. **Any puppy placing in sweepstakes and not shown in the Regular Classes, unless excused by the veterinarian, will be subject to forfeiture of all sweepstakes awards and prizes.** Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating the entry in Sweepstakes in the space for "Additional Classes."

Rough and smooth coats will be combined in the classes. Classes divided by sex.

### DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

25% of fees will be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 75% will be awarded to:  
Best in Sweepstakes - 20% of total entry Best of Opposite Sex -10% of total entry  
Balance will be divided among the winners in each class as follows (percentages are based on entry fees for each class): First Prize-40% • Second Prize- 30% • Third Prize- 20% • Fourth Prize- 10%.

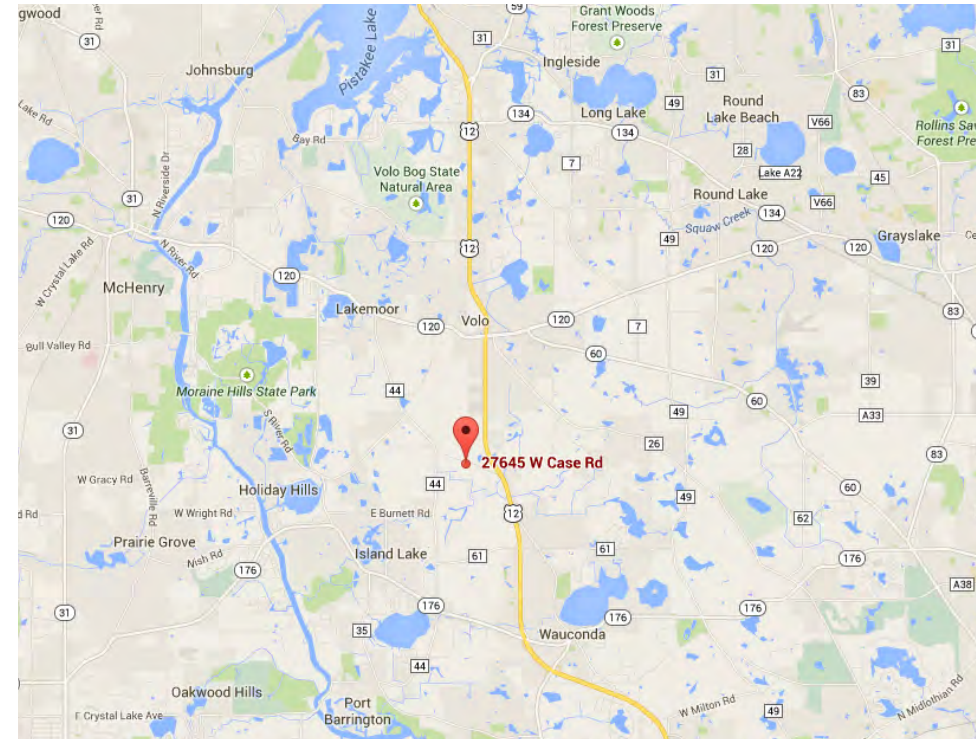
## DIRECTIONS TO SITE

AGREEMENT
