

SITE INFORMATION

In order for us to be able to keep using this facility please adhere to these rules. If we find anyone NOT following these rules they will be asked to leave without a refund of entry fees.

Please note that the building will NOT OPEN TILL 6:45 AM.

DO NOT COME ANY EARLIER THAN 6:45 AM. Overnight parking is not allowed.

Do not park in parking spots directly in front of the gymnastic club next to us.

There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles.

For those that are not able to prevent your dogs from barking, YOU MUST park in between the buildings so our neighbors in homes to the west aren't disturbed.

Do not walk your dogs along the fence on the west side of the drainage area. Walk dogs on the east side of the drainage area and along the south side of the buildings.

Protective matting is required under wire crates, grooming tables & chairs to protect the matted surface.

Absolutely NO CHALKING allowed in the building.

No dogs are allowed in the building overnight.

NO SMOKING IN THE BUILDING. NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE SITE.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE

From the east, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 ~3.7 miles to Algonquin Rd and turn left. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Rd and turn right. Drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Rd. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right onto Main St. Drive 1.4 miles on Main St to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Algonquin Road and turn left. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

From the north: take WI Hwy 120 south into IL where it becomes Hwy 47. Continue on 47 through Woodstock to Huntley and turn left onto Algonquin Rd. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

JUDGING PROGRAM

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having their dog ready at ringside at the scheduled time. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to call or locate dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

Entrants wishing to transfer from Regular conformation classes to Best of Breed or Rally/Obedience entrants wishing to move up to the next level of competition, must submit their requests in writing to the Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the day.
