Please close all latches and gates. **Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs and themselves!** Morning coffee will be available, donations are appreciated. Lunch will be sandwich boxes with chips, cookies and water. Tea, coffee, and bottled water will be available. Cost for lunch is \$5 per person; workers get free lunch.

Dogs MUST be confined in vehicles or crated. Crates/ex-pens need to be placed only in the areas designated by the Trial Committee. Dogs should be leashed when not in the arena. Bring your shade tents, chairs, water and rain gear. Transfer requests need to be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the day's test/trial.

## **DIRECTIONS TO SITE:**

**From the north on I-65:** Take Exit 20B to merge onto I-165 North

4.8 miles, take Exit 5 (US-68) toward Russellville/Bowling Green, turn left onto US-68

3.3 miles, turn Right onto KY-1083/Browning Rd

1.1 miles, turn Right onto Fuqua Rd, follow gravel drive to High Reaches Farm on Right

**From the south on I-65:** Take Exit 20A-B toward Owensboro/Scottsville

Take Exit 20B to merge onto I-165 North, then follow From the North directions above
