By **check or money order** (US funds, made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs. com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal** or **credit** card at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. Please send a separate payment for the total of each dog's entries. **Payment** <u>must</u> include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, July 2 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is preferred) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry pended; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via Zelle, PayPal, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial.

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

**Transfers:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Transfers to a higher level in Junior Showmanship may also be made. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary <u>at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging</u> for the show in which to be moved.

#### **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all French Bulldogs who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants must also be entered in a regular class in the Saturday AM specialty show. Champions of record by the closing date, and dogs with major points, cannot compete. Professional handlers can handle only dogs they own or co-own. Indicate the sweepstakes class, with age division, in the "Additional Classes" box on the entry form.

Classes are divided by sex: 6 mos & under 9 mos 9 mos & under 12 mos 12 mos & under 18 mos

#### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all French Bulldogs who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants do not need be entered in a regular class. Champions of record can compete. Professional handlers can handle only the dogs they own or co-own. Indicate the sweepstakes class, with age division, in the "Additional Classes" box on the entry form.

Classes are divided by sex: 7 years and under 9 years 9 years and older

#### **DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY**

35% will be deducted from each entry fee to help defray Sweepstakes expenses. The remainder (the "entry fund") will be divided amongst the class placements, determined by the number of entries:

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

<u>Novice class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, <u>have not</u> won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, <u>have</u> won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Novice class at a licensed or member show.

<u>Master class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the <u>front **and** back</u> of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

#### **AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay, or received payment for handling a dog.

### PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION

Saturday 9:00 am Entry fee \$10 per entry, 12 entry limit

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a Pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is for children at least 5 years of age and under 9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, a parent/quardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- ▶ A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- ▶ Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- ▶ All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- ▶ A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Each entry's adult member will sign a liability release as part of the entry process. Prizes will be awarded to all entrants. You may also register Saturday morning by 8:30am at the Secretary's desk, or send the form below with payment by check.



- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/ Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
