Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CST Wednesday, February 28th, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial **EXCEPT** that if cancellation is necessary due to COVID-19, entrants will receive full refunds. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Trial Secretary at least 30 min. prior to the class start time.

Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION (Sunday Only)

Requirements & Classification

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- · A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to
 maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- · The dog shown must be registered with AKC.
- · Dogs must be pre-entered.
- The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside
 of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead,
 provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of
 the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the
 dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

→

DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book, and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best Of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of
 Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best
 of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible winner.
- If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National AKC Owner-Handled Series.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.

Rules

1 Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under chapter 15, Sec. 1 of the AKC Rules regarding Registration & Dog Shows).

SLED DOG CLASSES

- 2 There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
- 3 If entered in a class for which full entry fee was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a Non-regular entry fee.
- 4 To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
 - a) During the previous racing season, the applicant must have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat on snow or 3.5 miles per heat with rigs on dry land, or the total miles per season not being less than forty-eight (48) miles. The 48 miles can consist of a combination of both snow and dry land races. All races must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
 - b) Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the SIed Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
 - c) Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 5 Dogs must be intact to exhibit in the Sled Dog Class.

A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged. The Show Secretary shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and total miles --or a five (5) year proof certificate--or copy of the Sled Dog Degree.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors as soon as the grooming area is demarcated on Friday, March 15, 2024, until 8:00 pm Friday and then again at 7:00 am on Saturday, March 16, 2024. Exercise pens are not allowed in the building. Please pick up after your dogs.

This is a **BRING YOUR OWN CHAIR** facility, none will be provided. The grounds chairman may alter your crating setup to better facilitate accommodation of crates and tables. Chairs allowed only at ringside, not in the grooming area.

PLEASE PARK ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS. There is a lot in front of the show building that will be marked, and overflow will be on the North side of the entrance drive.

BATHING FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE AT SHOW SITE – Tubs are available for indoor use if needed. \$10.00 per dog if you provide grooming products, \$15.00 per dog to use their products.

GENERAL

This is a self-cleaning show. All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Cleaning supplies will be provided. PLEASE POTTY DOGS ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS, AND DO NOT LET THEM URINATE ON BUILDINGS OR FURNITURE. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

- 1 (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
